**Map Information**

Public Water Systems (PWS) shown on this map provide an overview of infrastructure and water lines related to water systems in Pondera County.

Map data related to the Tiber Water District information is from a map prepared by TIBDI Engineering, and is displayed here for informational purposes only. The information is to provide a graphic overview of the general location and extent of the Tiber Water District. The water lines shown on this map do not include city water systems.

A public water system is a system that serves 25 or more people or has 25 or more service connections and operates at least 60 days per year. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) regulates all types of PWS in Montana with the exception of those owned and operated by the Native American nations. There are currently over 2,000 PWS in Montana and between 75 and 100 are added each year.
